Livestock Aid Centre (LAC)

A Livestock Aid Centre (LAC) is the unit of Veterinary and Animal Husbandry service delivery mechanism at Gram Panchayat level. An LAC may comprise of more than one Gram Panchayat. The LAC is headed by a Livestock Inspector/ Veterinary Technician, and at times has an attendant to assist in the Animal Husbandry services. There are a number of services provided by the LAC viz. Vaccination, Artificial Insemination, Castration, Extension Services etc. An LAC is the prime unit of livestock service delivery at the Gram Panchayat. There exist 3239 LACs in the State.

LACs are under the technical control of Veterinary Dispensaries/ Hospitals and discharges duties like vaccination, first-aid treatments, artificial insemination, extension activities and fodder development.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES AT LAC INCLUDES :

- 01. Veterinary health check-up and first-aid to ailing animals.
- 02. Preventive vaccination against contagious diseases.
- 03. Artificial insemination for reproduction and upgradation of the quality of the species of cows, she buffalos.
- 04. Organising animal health camps.
- 05. Facilitation of insurance for animals.
- 06. Monitoring of scheme animals and beneficiaries.
- 07. Knowledge dissemination activities related to animal husbandry sector.
- 08. Technical assistance to farmers for their self-employment.
- 09. LAC shall maintain proper stock account of the medicines procured and its usage.
- 10. Submission of monthly progress reports to the Veterinary Surgeon.
- Maintain database of farmers benefited under various AH initiatives.
- 12. Undertake routine deworming of livestock.
- 13. Sample survey.
- 14. Fodder promotions through minikits and perennial fodder cultivation.
- 15. Organise MVU camps in the area as per schedule.
- 16. 20 days monthly tour to villages for awareness building amongst farming communities.

- 17. Data uploading under INAPH and NADRS portal on AI and vaccination done under NADCP.
- 18. Attend all meetings at GP level and coordinate with line departments for convergence programme.
