- SMILE undertakes project in the fields of Rural Development, Livestock Management, Natural Resource Management, Human Resource Management.

### FUNDS:

The User Charges collected by SPAD is apportioned by Government to undertake capacity development program along with budget under State plan is placed to SMILE.

Veterinary Officers' Training Institute (VOTI) is the state level Training Institute of Fisheries & ARD Department, Government of Odisha, located at Laxmisagar, Bhubaneswar and established in the year 1994.

# Livestock Inspector's Training Centre (LITC)

There are 3 Livestock Inspectors Training Centres in the State catering the capacity building need of the Livestock Inspectors.

### 1. LITC, BOLANGIR:

This Centrewas established in the year 1961. The Centreis located 6 kms. away from Bolangir Town at Larkipalli.

### 2. LITC, CHIPILIMA:

This Centre was established in the year 1968. The Centre is located inside Chiplima Livestock Breeding Farm Complex, Sambalpur.

### 3. LITC, BHANJANAGAR:

This Centre was established in the year 1979. The Centrewas renamed in 1996 as Animal Husbandry Staff Training Institute & Extension Training Centre, (AHDSTI & ETC). The new building with hostel was constructed in the year 1981. The Centrehas been accredited to organise various trainings on A.I. in Frozen Semen Technology by Department of Animal Husbandry &Dairying, Government of India vide Accreditation Certificate No.CMU/AITI, Date of Issue 23.01.2020.

- To conduct basic 2 years Livestock Inspector (L.I.) Training course before induction of newly recruited L.Is.
- To organize in-service short course for paravets on technical and extension subjects.
- To organise livestock based livelihood training of line Department and Non Govt. Organizations.
