Scheme: Support to Farmers for Broiler Farming (200 Bird Capacity) under Deep Litter System in Individual Mode under OMBADC during the year 2020-21.

AIM:

The aim of the scheme is to support 880 farmers for setting up of Broiler farms with a capacity of 200 birds per unit during 2020-21.

SCHEME OBJECTIVE:

- To improve the livelihoods of the very poor mining affected communities especially belonging to ST & SC category.
- To build the capacity of the mining affected families for undertaking broiler farming in deep litter system as a profitable mini-enterprise.
- Livelihood promotion and income generation support to the mining affected farmers through small scale broiler farming.
- Nutritional support to family members of the mining affected families by availing poultry meat and also to fulfill their protein requirement.
- To support in doubling the farmers' income.
- To improve the economic status of rural under privileged.

SCHEME OUTLAY & SUBSIDY:

- Unit cost of 200 birds under Broiler Scheme is Rs.71,000.00
- Back ended subsidy @ 100% through DBT mode.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Very poor households in the mining affected villages shall only be selected as beneficiaries under this scheme.
- Priority will be given to ST & SC beneficiaries.

SOURCE OF FUNDS & CONTRIBUTION:

- Odisha Mineral Bearing Area Development Corporation (OMBADC)

COST OF ONE BROILER UNIT:

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH DBT:

- Rs.71,000.00 as back ended subsidy per farmer in total.
- **Subsidy under Ph-I**
 - Rs.20,000.00 towards construction of poultry shed up to lintel level.
- **Subsidy under Ph-II**
 - Rs.20,000.00 towards completion of construction of poultry shed.
- **Subsidy under Ph-III**
 - Rs.16,000.00 towards purchase of poultry feed for 3 weeks, equipment's, medicine, vaccine, litter material etc.
- **Subsidy under Ph-IV**
 - Rs.15,000.00 towards procurement and stocking of units with day-old poultry chicks (200 nos.) and purchase of poultry feed for 3 weeks.

SUPPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT:

- Training of farmers will be organized at Regional/ District/ Block level.
- Each farmer will be trained on construction of poultry houses, recommended management practices on feeding & watering, brooding and rearing young chicks, record keeping, etc.
- The concerned Livestock Inspectors, Gomitras and PraniMitras will guide the farmers in field for managing the broiler units.
- CDVOs shall assist in procurement and supply of chicks.
- Delivery of veterinary healthcare services by field functionaries through ongoing healthcare schemes and MVU Scheme.
- Routine vaccination of birds on priority basis.
- Assistance in marketing of surplus meat.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- Identification Proof (Aadhaar Card)
- Land Document/Lease Deed (Photocopy)
- Bank A/C No. with IFSC Code for DBT (Photocopy)
- Self-declaration with reference to member of WSHG.

PROCESS FOR PROVIDING SUBSIDY:

- Online application in the **ServicePlus** Portal
- BVO checks documents, upload photo and submit verification report to CDVO
- Approval by district CDVO and issue of Go-ahead
- Physical verification of the completion of poultry shed up to lintel level by Block Inspection Team (BIT)
- Release of first installment through DBT
- Physical verification towards completion of construction of poultry shed by Block Inspection Team (BIT)
- Release of second installment through DBT
- Towards purchase of poultry feed for 3 weeks , equipment's, medicine, vaccine, litter material etc. by Block Inspection Team (BIT)
- Release of third installment through DBT
- Physical verification of completed project & its management by BVO/ SDVO/ ADVO
- Release of final installment through DBT
