**Scheme: Support to Farmers for Establishment of “Innovative Poultry Productivity Project (IPPP)” Broiler Farming (600 Bird Capacity) under National Livestock Mission during the year 2020-21**

**AIM :**

The aim of the scheme is to support 200 farmers for setting up of IPPP Broiler units with a capacity of 150 birds per batch, totally to provisioning of 600 birds in 4 batches with 100 % subsidy during 2020-21

**SCHEME OBJECTIVE :**

- To strengthen the local Poultry Production Systems for enhancing livelihoods and also for generation of additional income among the farmers through broiler meat production.
- To support the nutritional requirement of the people through consumption of animal protein.
- To build the capacity of the farmers for undertaking broiler farming in deep litter system as a profitable mini-enterprise.
- To create self-employment in rural areas particularly among the women/ SC/ ST.
- To improve the economic status of rural under privileged.

**SCHEME OUTLAY & SUBSIDY :**

- Unit cost of 600 birds under Broiler Scheme is Rs.1,12,500.00
- Subsidy amount @ 100% for farmer
- State Share @ 40% amounts to Rs.45,000.00
- Central Share @ 60% amounts to Rs.67,500.00

**ELIGIBILITY :**

- The willing farmers/ entrepreneurs/ migrants farmers/ educated and unemployed youth
- Priority must be given to improve the livelihood of migrant workers of the state who have suffered serious economic loss and are in distress along with SC/ ST beneficiaries

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH DBT :

- Rs.1,12,500.00 as back ended subsidy per farmer in total.
- Ph-I (Rs.31,500.00) after completion of poultry shed and purchase of equipment's
- Ph-II (Rs.20,250.00) after stocking of birds under Batch-I
- Ph-III (Rs.20,250.00) after stocking of birds under Batch-II
- Ph-IV (Rs.20,250.00) after stocking of birds under Batch-III
- Ph-V (Rs.20,250.00) after stocking of birds under Batch-IV

## SUPPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT :

- Training of farmers will be organized at Regional/ District/ Block level.
- Each farmer will be trained on construction of poultry houses, recommended management practices on feeding & watering, brooding and rearing young chicks, record keeping, etc.
- The concerned Livestock Inspectors, Gomitras and Prani Mitras will guide the farmers in field for managing the Broiler units.
- CDVOs shall assist in procurement and supply of chicks.
- Delivery of veterinary health care services by field functionaries through ongoing health care schemes and MVU Scheme.
- Routine vaccination of birds on priority basis.
- Assistance in marketing of surplus meat.

## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED :

- Identification Proof (Aadhaar Card)
- Land Document / Lease Deed (Photocopy)
- Bank A/C No. with IFS Code for DBT (Photocopy)

## PROCESS FOR PROVIDING SUBSIDY :

- Online application in the **ServicePlus** Portal.
- BVO checks documents, upload photo and submit verification report to CDVO.
- Approval by district CDVO and issue of Go-ahead.
- Physical verification of the completion of poultry shed by Block Inspection Team (BIT)
- **Release of first installment through DBT**
- Physical verification of stocking of birds under Batch-I by BVO/ SDVO/ ADV0
- **Release of second installment through DBT**
- Subsequent physical verification of stocking of birds under Batch-II, Batch-III and Batch-IV by BVO/ SDVO/ ADV0 at an interval of 3 months
- **Release of Third, Fourth and Fifth installment through DBT**
