Scheme: Support to Farmers for Seasonal Fodder Cultivation during the year 2020-21

AIM:

The aim of the scheme is to support livestock farmers for seasonal fodder cultivation in their own land through distribution of 38288 nos. of minikits both in Kharif (28288 kits) & Rabi (10000) season during the year 2020-21.

SCHEME OBJECTIVE:

- To produce green fodder in farmers land indifferent seasons to feed their livestock.
- To build the capacity and sensitize the farming community for production of green fodder in different seasons and feeding practices to their livestock.
- To maintain the optimum productive and reproductive health status of the livestock.
- To minimize the milk production cost.

SCHEME OUTLAY & SUBSIDY:

- A total of 38,288 nos. of minikits will be distributed to farmers together both in Kharif (28,288 kits) & Rabi (10,000 kits) season.
- A total of 9572 acre (@ 25 acre per minikit) of land shall be brought under seasonal fodder cultivation during the 2020-21.
- Unit cost for one minikit amounts to Rs.415/- including logistic support for door step delivery to be provided to beneficiary free of cost.
- The seasonal minikits will be delivered at the door step of the farmers in two crop growing season i.e. Kharif and Rabi but the farmers who avail the benefit in one season shall not be considered for the other cropping season.

SCHEME OUTLAY & SUBSIDY:

- Beneficiaries should have large or small animals.
- SC/ ST/ Women Farmer/ MPCS/ SHG members should be given preference.
- Goshala may be included in this scheme, if not receiving any grant from Government schemes for fodder cultivation.
- The beneficiaries should have assured irrigation source for Rabi season fodder cultivation.

ASSISTANCE FOR ONE UNIT OF SEASONAL FODDER CULTIVATION:

The fodder seed minikit containing both cereal and legume fodder seed for 0.25 Ac. of land to be delivered at the door step of the beneficiary @ Rs.415/- per kit including transportation from the source to the farmer's door step.

SUPPORT FROM DEPARTMENT:

- Capacity building of the selected farmers for establishment of seasonal fodder plot and its maintenance with feeding practice to the animals.
- Assistance to the dairy farmers with technical inputs and seasonal fodder seed for establishment of seasonal fodder plot of 0.25 ac. in their own land.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- Aadhaar Card (Photocopy) for identification purpose.
- Geo-Tagged photograph of the selected plot for seasonal fodder cultivation.

PROCESS FOR PROVIDING SUBSIDY:

- Online Application in **ServicePlus** Portal.
- BVO checks documents, upload photo and submit verification report to CDVO.
- Supply of fodder seed minikit at the farmer's door step.
- Physical verification of land area, source of irrigation (for Rabi Season Crop) and field preparation for plantation of seasonal fodder crop, by the Block Inspection Team (BVO/ VAS/ AVAS/ LI/ Fodder Officer).
- Submission of the Geo-Tagged Photograph of the standing crop along with beneficiary

TRACKING STATUS OF APPLICATION & COMPLAINTS:

- Status can be tracked online in the **ServicePlus** Portal.
- SMS alerts to be provided to beneficiaries.
