Scheme: Support to Farmers for Establishment of Semi-Commercial Pig Farming in Individual Mode during the year 2021-22

AIM:

The aim of the scheme is to support 85 nos. of small entrepreneurs for setting up of pig farms with a capacity of 10 female + 1 male pig for income generation with provision of 40% subsidy during 2021-22.

SCHEME OBJECTIVE:

- To create small mother units with 10 sows and 1 boar at individual level.
- To support the nutritional requirement of the people through consumption of animal protein.
- To build the capacity of the farmers for undertaking pig farming as a profitable minienterprise.
- To create employment as well as enhance supplementary income for farmers in rural areas.

SCHEME OUTLAY & SUBSIDY:

- Unit cost of (10+1) pig farm under the Scheme is Rs.4,00,000/-
- Subsidy amount @ 40% amounts to Rs.1,60,000/-
- Share of farmers @ 60% amounts to Rs.2,40,000/-

ELIGIBILITY:

• The willing farmers / entrepreneurs / SC / ST / individual members

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH DBT:

- Rs.1.60 lakh as back ended subsidy per farmer in total.
- Ph-I (40% of Rs.1.60 lakh i.e. Rs.64,000/-) after completion of pig shed (sty).
- Ph-II (60% of Rs.1.60 lakh i.e. Rs.96,000/-) after stocking of piglets.

SUPPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT:

- Training will be organized at regional level or any other convenient place after final approval of the list.
- The skill upgradation training for individual will be arranged along with visit to a nearest pig farm under ongoing farmer capacity building program.
- Individual will be trained on recommended management practices on feeding, breeding, preventive health care, record keeping, etc.
- The concerned Livestock Inspectors, Gomitras and PraniMitras will have to guide the farmers in field for managing the pig units.
- The capacity building of Lls, Gomitras, PraniMitras will be taken up by the Deptt.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- Identification Proof (Aadhaar card)
- Land Document / Lease Deed (Photocopy)
- 60% of project cost to be Self Financed / Bank Loan
- If Bank Loan, Consent Letter from Bank
- Bank A/C No. with IFS Code for DBT (Photocopy)

PROCESS FOR PROVIDING SUBSIDY:

- Each individual farmers will apply online.
- BVO checks documents, upload photo and submit verification report to CDVO.
- Approval by district CDVO and issue of Go-ahead.
- Physical verification of the completion of pig sty by Block Inspection Team (BIT).
- Release of first installment through DBT.
- Physical verification of completed project & its management by BVO/ SDVO/ ADVO.
- Release of second / final installment through DBT.
