**Scheme: “Goat Farming through Women SHGs” for the year 2021-22**

**AIM:**

The scheme aims to support 2000 WSHGs to take up commercial goat rearing units for enhancing livelihoods and incomes of rural women.

**SCHEME OBJECTIVE:**

- To enhance livelihoods and incomes of SHG members through commercial goat farming.
- To increase the meat production in order to meet the growing demand in the state.

**SCHEME OUTLAY & SUBSIDY:**

- Unit cost of (30 + 2 capacity) goat farm = Rs.2,30,000/-
- Government Share @ 50% of unit cost amounts to Rs.1,15,000/- (Back Ended)
- Beneficiary Share @ 50% of unit cost amounts to Rs.1,15,000/- (WSHG Share)

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- The willing WSHG will be eligible to avail support.

**SOURCE OF FUNDS & CONTRIBUTION:**

- State Plan

**COST OF ONE GOAT UNIT:**

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH DBT:**

- Rs.1,15,000/- as back ended subsidy per unit.
- Phase-I: 40% of the eligible subsidy i.e., Rs.46,000/- after completion of goat shed.
- Phase-II: 60% of the eligible subsidy i.e., Rs.69,000/- after stocking of goats.

### SUPPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT:

- Trainings will be organized at Block Head Quarter level or any other convenient place after final approval of the list.
- Two members per SHG will be trained on recommended management practices on feeding and watering, vaccination, deworming, record keeping, etc.
- The concerned Livestock Inspectors, Gomitras and Prani Mitras will guide the farmers in field for managing the Goat units.
- The capacity building of LIs, Gomitras, Prani Mitras will be taken up by the BVOs.
- The local VAS/ AVAS/ BVO will guide WSHG to procure good quality goat.
- The BVO will provide all technical guidance to the beneficiaries for maintaining proper veterinary healthcare and immunization of the animals.

- Land Document / Lease Deed (Photocopy)
- 50% of Project Cost to be Self-Financed / Bank Loan
- If Bank Loan, Consent Letter from Bank
- Bank A/C No. with IFS Code for DBT (Photocopy)
- Self-Declaration with reference of WSHG

### PROCESS FOR PROVIDING SUBSIDY:

- Submission of application as per EOI floated by DSWO
- BVO checks documents, upload photo and submit verification report.
- Issue of Go-ahead letters by CDVO.
- Physical verification of the completion of Goat shed by Block Inspection Team (BIT)
- **Release of First Installment through DBT**
- Physical verification of completed project and its management by block level inspection team.
- **Release of Second / Final Installment through DBT**
