Scheme: Establishment of Small Scale Poultry Hatchery during the year 2021-22

## AIM:

The aim of the scheme is to support farmers for establishment of a poultry hatchery unit with 7,500 capacity for producing day old chicks.

# **SCHEME OBJECTIVE:**

- To establish hatching units of 7,500 egg setter and 2500 Hatcher capacity.
- To produce both broiler and LIT bird day-old chicks.
- To generate income by selling the day-old chicks to different poultry units.

## SCHEME OUTLAY & SUBSIDY:

- Unit cost for setting 7500 egg capacity hatchery unit scheme is Rs.6.60 lakh.
- Government share @ 40% of unit cost amounts to Rs.2.64 lakh (as back ended).
- Beneficiary share @ 60% of unit cost amounts to Rs.3.96 lakh.

## **ELIGIBILITY:**

- The interested farmers/ entrepreneurs will be finally selected at district level to set up hatchery units in areas where there is demand for LIT, broiler and other poultry day-old chicks for broiler and backyard poultry farming.
- They will be trained to manage hatchery units through on-farm training in various government hatcheries.

# FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH DBT:

- 1st Installment: 40% of the cost of the hatchery building as per actuals limited to i.e., Rs.1.06 lakh after construction of hatchery building.
- 2nd Installment: 40% of the cost of the machinery and equipment as per actuals upon production of GST bills, limited to Rs 1.06 lakh after installation of machinery.
- 3rd Installment: 20% of the cost of the eligible project cost, as per actuals, limited to Rs.0.52 lakh after 1st batch of incubation.

## SUPPORT FROM THE DEPARTMENT:

- Training will be organized at nearest Government poultry hatchery after final approval
  of the list.
- The hatchery unit will be managed by the beneficiary. However, initially they will engage a skilled worker for hatchery operation.
- Each beneficiary will be trained on hatchery management, marketing of chicks, record keeping, etc.
- The unit In-charge of nearest departmental hatchery will guide the farmer in field for managing the hatchery.

## **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:**

- 1. Identification Proof (Aadhaar Card).
- 2. Land Document / Lease Deed (Photocopy).
- 3. 60% of Project Cost to be Self-Financed / Bank Loan.
- 4. If Bank Loan, Consent Letter from Bank.
- 5. Bank A/C No. with IFS Code for DBT (Photocopy).
- 6. Self-Declaration with reference to member of WSHG.

## PROCESS FOR PROVIDING SUBSIDY:

- 1. Online application or in plain paper in the prescribed format.
- 2. BVO checks documents, upload photo and submit verification report to CDVO.
- 3. Approval by district CDVO and issue of Go-ahead.
- 4. Physical verification of the completion of construction of hatchery building by Block Inspection Team (BIT).
- 5. Release of first installment through DBT.
- 6. Physical verification of installation of machinery BVO / SDVO / ADVO.
- 7. Release of second / installment through DBT.
- 8. Physical verification of 1st batch of incubation.
- 9. Release of 3rd / Final installation through DBT.
