Scheme: Animal Health Certificate under Odisha Right to Public Services Act (ORTPSA)

AIM:

The aim of the service is to enable the citizens to receive Animal Health Certificate through an online platform.

SERVICE OBJECTIVES:

- To provide G2C (Government to Citizen) services for issue of Animal Health Certificate through ServicePlus portal.
- To enable electronic filing, receipt, processing and delivery of Animal Health Certificates by Veterinary Hospitals/ Dispensaries.
- To facilitate the process of delivery of Animal Health Certificates on an online mode without asking for the physical presence of the farmer at Veterinary Dispensary/ Hospital.

PROCEDURE FOR DELIVERY OF ANIMAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE:

- 1. Citizen applies online the application in the ServicePlus portal.
- 2. The self-attested scanned documents of ID proof have to be uploaded by the applicant.
- 3. BVO / Veterinary Officer undertake physical examination of the animals for which Animal Health Certificate is to be issued.
- 3. No fee will be charged for this service.
- 4. After processing and approval, the certificate will be delivered to the citizen through Email / log-in ID in which the citizen has applied for the certificate.

AUTHORITIES:

The following designated authorities are notified in conformity to provide the Animal Health Certificate for smooth and better management of the e-Certificate system.

- Designated Officer: Block Veterinary Officer/ Veterinary Assistant Surgeon/ Additional Veterinary Assistant Surgeon
- 2. Appellate Authority: Sub Divisional Veterinary Officer
- 3. Revisionary Authority: Chief District Veterinary Officer

DURATION FOR PROVIDING ANIMAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE:

Duration for providing the Animal Health Certificate is 5 days in head quarter areas and 7 days in peripheral areas of the designated officers.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- 1. Identification Proof (Aadhaar Card)
- 2. Passport size photograph of the applicant

TRACKING STATUS OF APPLICATION:

- 1. Status can be tracked online in the **ServicePlus** portal
- 2. SMS alerts to be provided to beneficiaries
