Scheme: Support to Farmers for Azolla Cultivation during the year 2020-21

AIM:

The aim of the scheme is to support 3140 nos. of women livestock farmers for establishment of Azolla Production Unit during the year 2020-21.

SCHEME OBJECTIVE:

- To produce very nutritious Azolla Feed Supplement to maintain and to enhance the productivity of the livestock.
- To benefit landless farmers for maintaining dairy animals or small animals.
- To promote skill development through simple and replicable low cost technology.
- To empower women and extend opportunity for participation of vulnerable population.

SCHEME OUTLAY & SUBSIDY:

- Unit cost for establishment of one Azolla Unit (2 mtr. x 2 mtr. X 0.20 mtr.) dimension is Rs.2,000/-.
- Back ended Subsidy @ 100% through DBT mode in two phases.

ELIGIBILITY:

- All categories of women farmers.
- Farmers having large or small animals.
- Women farmer from all categories including SC/ST to be included.
- Women members of MPCS / SHG / Fodder Co-operative Group will be given preference.
- The beneficiaries should give willingness to maintain the unit for at least 2(two) years.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH DBT FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF AZOLLA PRODUCTION UNIT:

- 1. Phase-I: Rs.300/- towards completion of digging of Azolla Pit as per specification.
- 2. Phase-II: Rs.1,700/- on completion of stocking, production and utilization.

SUPPORT FROM DEPARTMENT:

- Capacity building for selected beneficiary through demonstration for establishment of Azolla Unit.
- Sensitize women farmer for daily collection of Azolla from the unit and feeding Livestock as a highly nutritious feed supplement.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- Aadhaar Card (Photocopy) for identification purpose.
- Bank Pass Book First Page (Photocopy) Account No. with IFS Code.
- Agreement for maintenance of Azolla Unit for 2 years.
- Geo Tagged Photograph of the Azolla Unit.

PROCESS FOR PROVIDING SUBSIDY:

- Online Application in ServicePlus Portal.
- BVO checks documents, upload photo and submit verification report to CDVO.
- Approval by CDVO, issue of Go-Ahead Letter.
- Physical verification of digging of unit by Block Inspection Team (BVO/VAS/ AVAS/ LI/ Fodder Officer) with Geo-Tagged photograph.
- Release of first installment through DBT
- Procurement of inputs by the beneficiary.
- Physical verification of the unit post stocking by Block Inspection Team and submission of Geo-Tagged photograph of the Azolla unit.
- Release of second/ final installment through DBT
