# GUIDELINE FOR STATE SECTOR UMBRELLA SCHEME "MMKY- SCHOLARSHIP TO MERITORIOUS STUDENT OF FISHERS' FAMILY" FOR THE YEAR 2023-24

# 1. Introduction

Education in fishers' community is always being neglected due to its vulnerability. To generate interest among the children of this sector of the society onetime cash award incentive to the pass outs of HSC examination will be provided for higher education after admission into the higher course like CHSE/CBSE/ICSE'. To generate interest among the meritorious student of the fishers' family one-time assistance to the pass outs of HSC examination will be provided for higher education after admission in to the course.

# 2. Aim & Objective

The scheme will encourage meritorious students of fishers' family towards higher education after admission into the course. The assistance will be one time support to the meritorious student.

# 3. Target Group

Meritorious students of fishers' family.

# 4. Assistance Pattern

Percentage of marks secured in HSC Examination	Cash award (in Rs.)	
80 % and above	20000/-	
70% and up to 80%	15000/-	
60% and up to 70%	10000/-	

#### 5. Area of operation

The scheme shall be applicable to the entire State (30 DFOs/ 5 Marine Units). District Fisheries Officers/Additional Fisheries Officers, Marine of the respective coastal districts shall implement the scheme through field functionaries.

## 6. Criteria for selection and eligibility criteria

- i. The meritorious student of the fishers' family shall submit application in format (Annexure-1) with a copy of HSC Pass certificate, Mark sheet and College Admission receipt to Asst. Fisheries Officers of concerned block.
- ii. The verification will be done by respective AFO/ SFTA/ JFTA regarding genuineness of the certificate ascertaining from the respective Headmaster of the School and Principal of the collage.
- iii. After verification the AFO/SFTA/ JFTA shall submit the list of eligible student along with all relevant documents to the District Fisheries Officer.
- iv. The Scheme will encourage meritorious students of active fishermen towards higher education after admission into the course. The award will be awarded once to a meritorious student. This assistance will be extended over and above the prevailing scope by the School & Mass Education Department.
- v. The students availing scholarship under ST & SC Development, Minorities & Backward Classes Welfare Department, KALIA scheme etc. shall not be eligible to get scholarship under the said scheme. The concerned student must provide self declaration mentioning that he/she has not availed any kind of scholarship/award from any Department & countersigned by concerned AFO/ SFTA/ JFTA.

- vi. The concerned Addl. Fishery Officer (Marine) should submit the final list of meritorious students to concerned District Fisheries Officer to avoid duplication in coastal districts.
- vii. District Fisheries Officer shall release the assistance in the Aadhaar linked bank account of the student through DBT/ NEFT/ RTGS and maintain accounts for Audit purpose.
- viii. District official can enhance the it up to 25% of their allocated target and district officials are free to reallocate block targets as per demand (Lt. 883/FARD dt 21.1.23).
- ix. The complete list of the meritorious students shall be uploaded to the DSS portal by the AFOs so as to maintain transparency.

# 7. Monitoring, reporting and supervision:

Monitoring/reporting and supervision shall be done by the Director of Fisheries, Odisha through the respective District Fisheries Officers/ Additional Fisheries Officers, Marine.

#### 8. Publicity:

State level publicity is to be taken up by the Director of Fisheries, Odisha and subsequent district level publicity through posters and wall painting at school premises are to be entrusted to the District Fisheries Officers and Additional Fisheries Officers, Marine.
