GUIDELINES FOR STATE SECTOR UMBRELLA SCHEME- "MMKY-MACHHA CHASA PAIN NUA POKHARI KHOLA YOJANA (MPY)" FOR THE FY: 2023-24

1. BACKGROUND

Odisha is endowed with 6.76 lakh ha of inland fresh water resources which include 1.34 lakh of tanks/ponds, 2.00 lakh ha of reservoirs, 1.80 lakh ha of lakes, swamps & jheels and 1.71 lakh ha of rivers & canals. Over last 5 years, the freshwater fish production through aquaculture has grown at an impressive CAGR of 12% reaching 6.90 lakh metric tonne in 2022-23. For crop intensification in existing fish tanks and for expansion of freshwater fish production area, it is envisaged for excavation of new fish pond across the state under the State plan Scheme '**Machha Chasa Pain Nua Pokhari Khola Yojana (Matsya Pokhari Yojana)**

2. OBJECTIVES

- To create additional water bodies for intensive aquaculture in inland sector through excavation of new tanks/ponds in the State of Odisha.
- To promote intensive aquaculture in existing old tanks with low productivity.
- To ensure income generation and employment creation through promotion of freshwater aquaculture.
- To enhance the productivity upto 5 MT/ha/yr.

3. TARGET GROUP AND AREA OF OPERATION

- Interested farmers having land /pond shall be covered under this scheme with the following eligibility criteria.
- Must be a resident of Odisha and must possess identity and residential proof including Adhaar card.
- Must have a Bank Account in his/ her name in the State of Odisha.
- Must have requisite land free from all encumbrances (Documentary evidence in support of the lands needs to be produced by the beneficiary).
- The minimum of 0.20 Ha. up to maximum of 2.00 Ha. excavated area having a minimum water depth of 6 feet shall be considered for subsidy.
- If, a beneficiary has availed similar subsidy earlier for excavation of ponds for pisciculture under different scheme of Govt. of India or State Govt. for less than 2.00 ha., he/ she shall also be eligible to avail further subsidy for balance area keeping overall maximum limit up to 2.00 ha. under the scheme.
- While availing subsidy, beneficiary family will be considered instead of individual member of family. One beneficiary family should not be provided with multiple benefit under one particular scheme. A family will not be eligible for subsidy under the same scheme if any of its members has got subsidy during last three years.
- The farmers having their own/leased old existing ponds with very low productivity.

6. IMPLEMENTATION PROCEDURE AND RELEASE OF SUBSIDY

6A. Component-1

Intensive Aquaculture in newly excavated tanks

- The scheme shall be widely publicised across the State through Departmental website, print/electronic/social media.
- Interested persons shall apply through Go-SUGAM portal with requisite documents (**Annexure-III A**). In case the applicant cannot apply online in Go-SUGAM due to Bhulekh (RoR) verification issue, the required ROR shall be scanned and uploaded to the site by Beneficiary/AFO after receiving the same in offline mode in the prescribed application format (**Annexure-III**). All offline applications shall be uploaded in Go-sugam site before issue of Go-ahead.

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- iii. The application shall include documentary evidence of availability of requisite land (either own/registered lease deed) free from all encroachments and encumbrances, necessary clearance/permission if any required. In case of leased land the lease period/agreement must not be less than 7 years from the date of application.
 - iv. **In case of joint property and property ROR in the name of ancestors, the affidavit should be made before the Executive Magistrate in the name of applicant which should contain declaration/consent by other shareholders/their legal heirs of the land to take up the project by the applicant under govt. assistance. The applicant shall submit disclaimer that in case of any complaint received from any party on dispute of land the subsidy amount will be refunded to Government.**
 - v. Preference shall be given to ST/ SC/PWD/Transgender applicants in selection of beneficiaries.
 - vi. On receipt of application from the applicant the AFO of the Block shall visit the site and submit the survey and technical feasibility report (**Annexure-IV A**), along with all documents to the DFO within 15 days.
 - vii. The AFO shall take 5 Geo tagged photographs of the site where the fish pond is proposed for excavation and upload in portal.
 - viii. On receipt of applications along with documents from the AFO through Go-Sugam/ offline, the DFO shall convene the District Level Committee (DLC) meeting under the Chairmanship of the Collector for approval of the eligible beneficiaries as per notification no 834/FARD dt.21.01.23
 - ix. Upon approval of DLC, DFO shall issue Go-ahead letter (**Annexure-VA**) to the beneficiary to take up excavation work.
 - x. The AFO of the concerned block shall visit the site time to time, to guide the beneficiary during pond development and render technical support during culture period.
 - xi. Beneficiary shall submit RI verification report, during execution of the project and submit an undertaking that tank has been constructed in his/ her own plot / leased plot before release of subsidy.
 - xii. Geo tagged photograph of the project shall be taken by AFO along with the beneficiary before starting, during excavation and after completion of the project and upload in Go-Sugam portal.
 - xiii. The beneficiary shall inform the AFO about completion of the project along with RI verification Report.
 - xiv. The AFO shall make field visit, and submit the completion certificate to the DFO along with all photographs within 15 days from the date of intimation by beneficiary.
 - xv. AFO shall physically verify 100% of the completed projects. The utilization certificate, certified input bills / vouchers, geo-tagged photographs (*AFO and the beneficiary both should be visible along with the Asset created*) shall be uploaded by the AFO for release of subsidy. The admissible subsidy shall be released to the beneficiary account in DBT / RTGS / NEFT.
 - xvi. DFO/ Addl. F.O/ AFO(HQ) of the district shall verify / cross check, minimum 25% of the project separately. (The DFO shall earmark percentage of projects to be inspected by each officer himself/herself, Addl.F.O/ AFO,HQ).They shall visit the projects immediately after completion of excavation and before stocking.
 - xvii. Zonal Deputy Director of Fisheries shall verify, at least 5% of the completed cases. These 5% cases shall be other than the 25% of cases inspected as mentioned in Para XIV. However, release of subsidy shall not be linked to inspection of projects by Zonal DDFs.
 - xviii. After completion of excavation (Unit Capital cost @Rs.7.00 lakh/ ha), the proportionate capital subsidy of the water area developed shall be released in favour of beneficiary on receipt of utilization certificate and 4(four) projects site Geo-tagged photographs from all angles and 1(one) photograph with beneficiary by AFO.
 - xix. After stocking of fingerlings, admissible input subsidy shall be released to the beneficiary on receipt of input bills (GST bills where ever applicable) certified by AFOs.
 - xx. Geo-tagging and photographic documentation (pre, during and post excavation) and asset created shall be taken up by the AFO to ensure transparency. The details of the beneficiary and photographs of the works shall be kept in the case records and also uploaded in the website of the Directorate of Fisheries.
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- xxi. Horticulture activity on the pond embankment shall be encouraged and taken up by the fish farmers at their own cost for additional income. The District Fisheries Officer shall co-ordinate with Horticulture Department in the District for this purpose.
- xxii. Sign board must be displayed on the embankment of pond with details of scheme, funding, subsidy, area, name, address of beneficiary and year of implementation etc.
- xxiii. The back ended subsidy shall be released directly to the beneficiary account on completion of the project through DBT/ RTGS/ NEFT in the Adhaar linked bank account of the beneficiary.
- xxiv. The beneficiary shall submit the GST bills (where ever applicable)/ receipts towards procurement of inputs.
- xxv. The DFO and AFO shall ensure proper utilization of water area created under the scheme for scientific pisciculture.
- xxvi. The implementation guidelines and unit cost may be changed as per circular/ instruction of Govt. from time to time.
- xxvii. District official can enhance it up to 25% of their allocated target and district officials are free to reallocate block targets as per demand (Lt. 883/FARD dt 21.1.23).
- xxviii. The AFOs /DFOs should facilitate credit linkage from banks to the beneficiary for availing loans as per the requirement of the beneficiary in Bank Finance case.
- xxix. DFOs to assess the progress of each projects after a period of three months from the date of issue of the Go ahead then issue one month notice for immediate initiation of the project if not yet started. After one month of the notice the same may be cancelled if no progress is observed. DFOs are allowed to review the reasons of non-initiation from case to case basis with justified reasons(Except bank finance case).

- i. For differently-abled persons the certificate of disability issued by certifying authority/ competent authority indicating 40% or more disability as per 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 will be acceptable. The certificate of identity as transgender person issued by District Magistrate as per 'The Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act 2019 will be accepted as Transgender category.
- ii. **In case Government in F & ARD Department enhance the percentage of subsidy, that shall be applicable for those beneficiaries who have received Go ahead letter during the FY 2023-24.**

Subsidy @ 40 % shall be provided to the General category and @ 50% to SC/ ST/ Women/ PWD/ Transgender categories of beneficiaries.

The component II would be made operational only upon provision of funds with specific communication.

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6B.2: IMPLEMENTATION PROCEDURE AND RELEASE OF SUBSIDY

- i. The beneficiary should not have availed subsidy under MPY and PMMSY or any other similar assistance during last 5 years against the tank to be included under this scheme.
- ii. The interested beneficiaries shall apply to AFO in the prescribed application format (**Annexure-III**) with all document as per checklist (**Annexure-IIIA**).
- iii. The application shall include documentary evidence of availability of requisite pond (either own/registered lease deed) free from all encroachments and encumbrances, necessary clearance/permission if any required. In case of leased pond the lease period/agreement must not be less than 7 years from the date of application.
 - i. **In case of joint property and property ROR in the name of ancestors, the affidavit should be made before the Executive Magistrate in the name of applicant which should contain declaration/consent by other shareholders/ their legal heirs of the land to take up the project by the applicant under govt. assistance. The applicant shall submit disclaimer that in case of any complaint received from any party on dispute of land the subsidy amount will be refunded to Government.**
- iv. On receipt of application from the applicant the AFO of the block shall visit the site and submit the survey and technical feasibility report (**Annexure-IV B**) along with all documents, to the DFO within 15 days. AFO should certify that the tank is suitable for intensive aquaculture, with proper embankments etc.
- v. The AFO shall take 4 Geo tagged photographs of the site from all four angles as initial phase and submit the same to the DFO, along with other documents.
- vi. On receipt of applications along with documents from the AFO through Go-Sugam/ offline (to be made online before release of subsidy), the DFO shall convene the DLC meeting under the Chairmanship of the Collector for approval of the eligible beneficiaries as per FARD notification no. 834/FARD dt.21.01.23
- vii. Upon approval of DLC, DFO shall issue Go-ahead letter (**Annexure-VB**) along with DPR to the beneficiary to take up intensive aquaculture.
- viii. The Assistant Fisheries Officer of the concerned block shall visit the site time to time to guide the farmers and render technical support during culture period.
- ix. Geo-tagged photograph of the project shall be taken by AFO along with the beneficiary 1st during Stocking, 2nd culture period with proper feeding and 3rd during harvesting.
- x. The beneficiary shall inform the AFO about stocking of fish seed and procurement of fish feed.
- xi. The AFO shall make field visit during the stocking of fish seed and procurement of feed and submit the certified input bills, photographs along with part UC to the DFO for release of 50% eligible subsidy.
- xii. Upon completion of harvest the AFO shall submit the certified input bills, photographs along with final UC to the DFO for release of balance 50% subsidy.
- xiii. AFO shall physically verify 100% of the completed projects. The utilization certificate certified input bills / vouchers, geo-tagged photographs (*AFO and the beneficiary both should be visible along with the Asset*) shall be uploaded by the AFO for release of subsidy. The admissible subsidy shall be released to the beneficiary account in DBT / RTGS / NEFT.
- xiv. DFO/ Addl. F.O/ AFO(HQ) of the district shall verify / cross check, minimum 25% of the project separately. They shall visit the projects immediately after completion of excavation and before stocking.
- xv. Zonal Deputy Director of Fisheries shall verify, at least 5% of the completed cases. These 5% cases shall be other than the 25% of cases inspected as mentioned in Para XIII. However, release of subsidy shall not be linked to inspection of projects by Zonal DDFs.
- xvi. Geo-tagging and photographic documentation (pre and during culture period) of the asset shall be taken up by the AFO to ensure transparency. The details of the beneficiary and photographs of the works shall be kept in the case records and also uploaded in the website of the Directorate of Fisheries.
- xvii. Sign board must be displayed on the embankment of pond with details of scheme, funding, subsidy, area, name and address of beneficiary, year of implementation etc.

- xviii. The back ended subsidy shall be released directly to the beneficiary account on completion of the project through DBT/NEFT/RTGS in the Adhaar linked bank account of the beneficiary.
- xix. The beneficiary shall submit the GST bills (where ever applicable)/ receipts towards procurements of inputs.
- xx. The DFO and AFO shall ensure for scientific pisciculture under the scheme.
- xxi. The implementation guidelines and unit cost may be changed as per circular/ instruction of Govt. from time to time.
- xxii. District official can enhance it up to 25% of their allocated target and district officials are free to reallocate block targets as per demand (Lt. 883/FARD dt 21.1.23).
- xxiii. The AFOs /DFOs should facilitate credit linkage from banks to the beneficiary for availing loans as per the requirement of the beneficiary in Bank Finance case.

7. TRAINING AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT OF BENEFICIARIES

To generate awareness, dissemination of farming technology and to attract the interested stake holders on the benefit of the scheme necessary training and awareness programme will be conducted.

8. Project Monitoring and Supervision:

8.1 District level Monitoring

The District Fisheries Officers along with his/her team of officers shall regularly supervise the scheme implementation including progress of selection of beneficiary, installation of units, stocking of fish seed, training and capacity building of the beneficiaries, release of subsidy etc.


8.2. State Level Monitoring

State Level Monitoring Committee will be constituted at Directorate of Fisheries, Odisha under the Chairmanship of the Director of Fisheries, Odisha. The committee members are:

- i. Director of Fisheries (Chairman)
- ii. Additional Director (Technical)
- iii. Joint Director (Inland)
- iv. Joint Director (Planning and Training)
- v. Deputy Director (Inland)

The Monitoring Committee will meet once in each quarter to monitor and review the progress of scheme implementation.

The Committee shall review the progress of work made by the DFOs and suggest guidance and advice.
